Last weekend, Klosters was treated to 3 very special quality concerts celebrating the 15th anniversary of Klosters Christmas Concerts.

The carefully curated programme by Stephen Johns, Artistic Director of the Royal College of Music, and Artistic Director of the Christmas concerts, presented a traditional mix of Christmas sounds and beautiful music that showcased the soloists, combined with a selection of works performed at the coronation of King Charles III at Westminster Abbey. The weekend began with a “gemutlich” evening in the Silvretta Parkhotel with a programme of short pieces with a mixture of everything from solos to choral works all interspersed with humour and light heartedness.

On Saturday, there was a more serious concert in St Jakobs Church with its unique acoustics – this was a seriously polished evening with magnificent performances from all the artists.

On Sunday, the concert featured more choir, organ, and Christmas repertoire and some traditional English carols, again with all the musicians performing together or solo. Remarkable talent was shown by the young musicians and soloists from the Royal College of London, the remarkable tenor Theodor Uggla and soprano Madeline Boreham, the combined magnificent voices of the Klosters London Singers and the Lund Switzerland Singers conducted by Felix Bagge.
